Flag Flying Programme.

5 April	Pitcairn Islands	Pitcairn flag
16 April	Battle of Culloden (1745)	Kings Colours
21 April	Birthday of Her Majesty the Queen (b.1926)	Union
23 April	Saint George's Day	St. George's
25 April	Anzac Day	Australian

The Pitcairn Islands are British Overseas Territories in the Pacific Ocean that officially became a British Colony in 1838. Their flag depicts a Union Jack in its canton (corner of the flag).

ANZAC Day, (an acronym formed from the initial letters of the Australian and New Zealand Army Corps), is a national day of remembrance in Australia and New Zealand that commemorates those who served and died in all wars, conflicts and peacekeeping operations.

We fly some Commonwealth country flags, particularly those that have the Union Jack canton, as an acknowledgement of our proud British heritage.

The St. George flag will be flown most of the time in between other appointed flags.
