Our meeting was held on Tuesday 31st January 2023. Plenty to discuss and whilst some items were concluded, others are still ongoing. Meeting lasted 1½ hours.

Matters arising.

King's Coronation.

A village volunteer group has been set up and they requested a donation to cover the costs. It was agreed to support this with £300.00 to come from the budget 2023/2024 and £200.00 to come from reserves.

Circular Bench.

We agreed to remove two of the six circular sections of the bench under the horse chestnut tree on the village green and resite them opposite the George Wybrow's former home.

Wickham St Pauls Consolidated Trust.

A meeting took place on 30th January 2023 with all 6 members of the trust and by two thirds majority it was agreed to distribute the money and close the Trust. The next meeting will be on the 1st. March to define the recipients.

Telephone Box Painting.

It was agreed to accept BT's offer to paint the telephone box this summer.

Additional Trees.

We have now planted ten various fruit trees at the top end of the Green, which should give us a nice display of blossom in spring and the fruits can be sampled by the wildlife, residents and visitors in summer and autumn.

We also planted three more ornamental trees, one of which is dedicated to the memory of Tony Ward.

Village Hall Pond.

The excavated pond is now full and we calculated that it holds about 600,000 litres of water (125,000 gallons in old money) and if we get another extreme dry summer, it is big enough to support wildlife.
