CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

May 2023 - April 2024

As Chairman of the Parish Council, I welcome you all here tonight, it's nice to see so many people supporting this assembly particularly as there are a number of residents who are committed to choir practice on a Tuesday.

Firstly, I would introduce our County Councillor Peter Schwier and our District Councillor David Holland but neither of them has been able to attend. Both of them are on the Planning committee which also meets on a Tuesday night, so they must be busy with Counsel work. They do attend our meetings and keep us well informed on matters occurring that affect our area. So, thank you both for your help during the year.

I would also like to introduce your Parish Council members;

Firstly, our Clerk and Financial officer Diane Jacob who keeps us all up to scratch and watches the pennies, she recently achieved a successful in-depth audit of the accounts. I have to say that these government auditors are very strict so it's great to have an unqualified audit.

Firstly, then I want to talk about the Parish Council activities.

Financial Matters – I am pleased to announce that 2024 is the first time in several years that we made our budget and ended up with a few pounds in the account. You may well ask why we increased the Parish Council rate again this year. We made budget but we did not have to hold an election this year and that saved around a £1000 and came out £300 to £400 up. It could so easily have gone the other way. Also, we have depleted our reserves over the years and we feel that we need to strengthen them a little. The increase is an average of £1.36 a month and if we did not increase the rate there would come a time when we would need to have a huge increase. The precept that we receive, unlike many Parishes around us, is our only source if income. We do not benefit from land rentals or house rentals. The Council feels that small increases each year as the cost-of-living dictates is more acceptable.

There have been several attempts during the year to engage with Essex County Council Highways department but with little success. From the natural water leak on The Green, Horse beware signs on Park Road and Church Road to Unsuitable for heavy goods vehicles signs on Old Road and an extension of the 30 MPH area on Park Road we have received little response or rejection. We have offered meetings but Highways refuse to attend meetings on site. We have therefore asked our County Councillor for his advice.

Planning Matters

The Parish Council has processed several applications by response to each application, supporting most and commenting positively on others. We have little influence in the final decisions that are made by Braintree District Council Planning department but we keep trying.

Local Bus Service

We have responded to the survey but found it very limiting. You could only answer the questions posed and they did not necessarily cover the points we wanted to make. We made separate comments on those and can only hope it will inform the decision although we are not optimistic about its continuation.
